

HALF DAY DELHI SIGHTSEEING

We visit Jama Mosque, one of the largest mosques of India followed by a rickshaw ride through the narrow lanes of Chandni Chowk to complete the experience of Old Delhi. We will also be visiting Asia's largest spice Market Khari Baori. We then proceed to visit Red Fort.

Later we drive back to the hotel through New Delhi's wide boulevards which offers everchanging perspectives of Lutyen's landscaped city. We briefly stop for photography at India Gate and then drive passed magnificent Parliament Building and before heading back to our hotel.
